
Integrating SEL into the Classroom:

How to Build SEL into Daily Classroom Instruction

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Program Description: The social and emotional well-being of students is a priority for schools. Yet, for many students, there are limited opportunities to learn these important skills. In this webinar, participants will learn practical ways to move SEL competencies and skills from separate programs into curriculum and classroom instruction, where students need them the most.

Program Outcome: Participants will integrate social and emotional competencies into curriculum and instruction by

- organizing units of study around SEL skills
- incorporating examples from literature, real people, and events, that are studied in different disciplines
- · developing guiding questions focused on SEL skills
- building management and self-regulation tools into multi-step projects
- addressing student mindset and identity as learners as part of the learning process
- incorporating metacognition into learning routines

<u>Session One</u>: Participants will learn how to integrate SEL competencies into content area curriculum and instruction through the literature, people, and events studied in class and the questions used to discuss them.

<u>Session Two</u>: Participants will learn strategies for supporting student metacognition so students own their learning, are aware when meaning-making breaks down, and can strategize how to adjust their learning to become independent, self-regulated leaners.
